

Exercises on „have to“ and „going-to future“

At the moment they all have to do boring things but they are going to do exciting things soon!

Write sentences with “have to” and “going-to future” on a piece of paper

Mr. Carter:

Today – clean car/ next week – go on holiday

“Today **I have to clean** the car, but next week **I am going to go** on holiday with my car.”

Mrs. Parker:

Today – drive bus/ tomorrow – sit in park

“Today **I have to drive** the bus, but tomorrow **I am going to sit** in the park.”

Mr Clarke:

Today – repair the bike/ tomorrow – go on a bike-tour



Kirsty:

At the moment – do maths in school/ tonight – dance ballet.

Amy:

This week – learn for an English test/ next week – play basketball every day.



The Stubbs:

Today – work in the garden/ tonight – have a barbeque (grillen)

Mrs Eichert:

This morning – teach English/ this afternoon – meet friends
